Individual departures for PRAGUE.

Tuesday, July 2 – JULIŠ ★★★★★, Prague Dinner

Individual arrivals in PRAGUE. Transfer from Václav Havel Airport to the Juliš Hotel located at the Wenceslas Square. Welcome dinner.

Wednesday, July 3 – JULIŠ ★★★★★, Prague Breakfast & Lunch

City tour, lunch, free afternoon for personal exploration.

Thursday, July 4 – JULIŠ ★★★★★, Prague Breakfast

Departure to KLADNO, birthplace of Chicago mayor Antonín Čermák. Lunch and shopping at strawberry farm Jahodárna VRAŇANY. Stop at Jan Palach's monument in VŠETATY. Afternoon free. Sokol Slet in the evening. (<https://slet2024.cz/en/>)

Friday, July 5 – JULIŠ ★★★★★, PRAGUE Breakfast

Optional visit to Sokol Slet. Free day with the option for genealogical trips to be arranged.

Saturday, July 6 – TRINITY ★★★★★, Olomouc Breakfast

Morning departure for Olomouc, followed by an afternoon city tour.

Sunday, July 7 – WAWEL QUEEN ★★★★★, Krakow Breakfast & Dinner

Departure for Poland, visiting the extermination camp AUSCHWITZ. Afternoon continue to KRAKOW. Dinner at the hotel.

Monday, July 8, WAWEL QUEEN ★★★★★, Krakow Breakfast

Tour of KRAKOW, followed by an afternoon excursion to the Salt Mines in WIELICZKA.

Tuesday, July 9 – GRAND PRAHA ★★★★★★, Tatranská Lomnica Breakfast

Passing the scenic area of the North Tatras, the tour continues to SLOVAKIA. Dinner at the hotel.

Wednesday, July 10 – GRAND PRAHA ★★★★★★, T. Lomnica Breakfast & Dinner

Full day excursion to LEVOČA, featuring a fascinating medieval altar in a local church, and BARDEJOV, famous for its historical architecture and sights.

Thursday, July 11 – MARIÁNSKÝ DVŮR ★★★★★, Uherské Hradiště Breakfast

Return to CZECHIA with a stopover in TRENČÍN.

Friday, July 12 – JULIŠ ★★★★★, Prague Breakfast

Morning visit of the local SLOVÁCKÉ MUSEUM featuring folklore costumes (kroje) from the entire region.

Saturday, July 13 – JULIŠ ★★★★★, Prague Breakfast & Dinner

Day at leisure in PRAGUE. Evening dinner cruise with round-trip transfers.

Saturday, July 14 Breakfast

Transfer to the airport for departure to the United States.
