Airfare: Not included. Each participant is responsible for booking their own flight.

Tour Package Includes:

Accommodation is confirmed in twin/double rooms with private facilities and buffet breakfast provided for the duration of the trip. You will travel in comfort with a motorcoach equipped with air conditioning for the entirety of your trip (middle-sized bus for group of up to 17 participants, full-size for 18 and more). Our experienced English-speaking professional guide will accompany you throughout the journey, along with local guides in Bratislava and Vienna, ensuring you gain insight into the rich history and culture of each destination. Sunday, August 2

Individual departures for PRAGUE.

Monday, August 3 – JULIŠ ★★★★★, Prague **Dinner**

Individual arrivals in PRAGUE. Transfer from Václav Havel Airport to the Juliš Hotel, located on Wenceslas Square. Free afternoon. Welcome dinner within walking distance.

Tuesday, August 4 – JULIŠ ★★★★★, Prague **Breakfast**

City tour including Strahov Monastery, Loreta Shrine, and Prague Castle. Free afternoon for further exploration of PRAGUE.

Wednesday, August 5 – JULIŠ ★★★★★, Prague **Breakfast**

Excursion to LYSÁ NAD LABEM (Botanicus herbal garden and living craft village) and PODĚBRADY (Bohemian Crystal glassworks).

Thursday, August 6 – GRANDHOTEL ★★★★★, Brno **Breakfast**

Departure to Moravia with a visit to the UNESCO site in ŽDÁR NAD SÁZAVOU, designed by Santini, followed by POLIČKA, the birthplace of composer Bohuslav Martinů, and OLEŠNICE, known for Danzinger's traditional modrotisk (indigo print workshop).

Friday, August 7 – NH GATE ONE ★★★★★, Bratislava **Breakfast**

After breakfast, departure southeast through the CHŘIBY hills with a visit to the beautiful chateau in BUCHLOVICE. Continue toward Slovakia via the STRÁNÍ border crossing, with a possible stop at the AUSTERLITZ Monument to Peace.

Saturday, August 8 – MARIEL ★★★, Znojmo **Breakfast**

Full-day excursion to VIENNA.

Sunday, August 9 MARIEL ★★★, Znojmo **Breakfast**

Morning visit to the Rotunda of St. Catherine, followed by the famous monastery in LOUKA near ZNOJMO. Visit to the well-known collection of Alfons Mucha's monumental paintings, The Slavic Epic, in MORAVSKÝ KRUMLOV.

Monday, August 10 – JULIŠ ★★★★★, Prague **Breakfast**

Visit to a farm in NÍHOV, home of Petra Burianová, winner of the Czech edition of the Bake Off series, including a baking lesson. Arrival in PRAGUE in the evening.

Tuesday, August 11 – JULIŠ ★★★★★, Prague **Breakfast**

Full-day excursion to PLZEŇ, including a visit to the Pilsner Urquell Brewery and the Great Synagogue.

Wednesday, August 12 – JULIŠ ★★★★★, Prague **Breakfast & Dinner**

Full day at leisure in PRAGUE, with recommendations provided for optional activities. Farewell dinner.

Thursday, August 13 – JULIŠ ★★★★★, Prague **Breakfast**

Transfer to the airport for departure to the United States.
